



Article 1

Team Sky Friuli in collaboration with the municipality of Chiusaforte, Sella Nevea System and us Raibl organizes Sunday April 22 2018 the 62nd edition of the "Monte canin ski mountaineering" Promotional event of ski mountaineering in pairs and individual, open to all without restrictions federal membership card with the requirement of the sports medical certificate valid at 22.04.2018.

The integral path has a length of about 18 km and a positive difference in height of about 1200meters.

The reduced route has a length of about 9,5 km and a positive difference in height of about 1200meters.

As regards regulation and mandatory equipment for participation in the event, reference is made to the rules contained in art.10 of the FISI regulation governing the national ski mountaineering competitions.

Article 2: REGISTRATION

Registration requirements

All athletes can sign up but only if adults and in possession of a sports medical certificate for the competitive activity valid till april 22 2018, for the short path can sign up also the athletes minors until 16 years and with an authorisation from a parent.

Registration becomes effective when:

- 1) fill out and subscribing the appropriate registration form (online or paper)
- 2) pay the registration fee (keep receipt of payment and eventually exhibit it at the race package withdrawal)
- 3) delivered a copy of the competitive medical examination valid at least until the day of the event (attaching it to the paper enrollment at the affiliated shops; or sending it as a clearly legible photo via whatsapp at n° 3497736022 or by sending it by mail to teamskyfriul@gmail.com).

IMPERATIVE: IN CASE OF LACK OF PAYMENT RECEIPT AFTER 5 DAYS FROM THE PRE-ENROLLMENT, THE REGISTRATION IS CANCELED.

The online registrations will open on 01 February 2018 and will close on 21 April 2018 at 12.00 or at the achievement of 200 members.

It will be possible to register on the day of the race, if there will be places available, with a surcharge of €



5.00.

The registration fee is non-refundable in case of non-participation in the race.

In case of cancellation on the days before the event due to force majeure, the organization reserves the right to reimburse a percentage equal to 50% of the registration fee paid. This percentage is justified by the multiple expenses that the organization has already made and which it can not recover.

In case of interruption or cancellation on the day of the event due to weather conditions, or for any other reason independent of the organization, no refund will be due to the participants.

Article 3

The bib and race package pick-up operations will take place on April 22, 2018 from 7.00 am to 8.30 am at the multifunctional Sella Nevea.

Article 4

The on-line departure will be given at 9.00 am at the piazzale Slovenia in the Ex Funivia building area in Sella Nevea in the municipality of Chiusaforte (UD).

Article 5

- Competitors must wear during the race the required equipment and wear bibs for the entire course;
- It's mandatory to follow the marked route: green uphill, red downhill, yellow technical sections;
- The changes of the skins, where reported and indicated, by the staff are mandatory;



- Some “dangerous” sections will be marked by a special white and red ribbon: for safety, please do not leave these corridors;
- In the technical sections marked with yellow it’s mandatory to remove skis, remove the skins, fasten them in to the rucksack and go up the slope;
- DESCENT TRAKS IN THE TRACK: some stretches are in common with the ski slope and users are advised of the presence of the race. However, please respect the behavioral safety rules for themselves and for the skiers;
- It is strictly forbidden to throw flasks or other material during the course, the offenders will be penalized as FISJ regulation;
- The behavioral rules and indications described in the FISJ regulation art. 10-ski mountaineering;

Article 6: PATH

The route and altimetry are shown on the website of the event. The INTEGRAL path has length of ca.18 km for 2150 m D+, the reduced one has length of ca.9,5 km for 1200 m D+.

Eventually changes of the route will be communicated by the race director or the course director.

Competitors must be strictly respect the race appropriately marked path with appropriate signs.

The removal from the official path, as well as involving the disqualification from the order of arrival, will be at the sole risk and danger of the competitor.

Article 7: WEATHER

In case of important weather phenomena (thick fog, heavy snowfall, sudden change of temperature), the organization reserves the right to make changes, even during the course of the race, in order to eliminate potential dangers (avalanches) or strong conditions uncomfortable for the participants. Any changes will be communicated to the participants and reported by the employees. The organization also reserves the right to suspend or cancel the race if the weather put the safety of the participants, volunteers or the rescuers at risk.

Article 8

On the put will be present employees of the organization in constant contact whit the base.

The ambulance with paramedics will be stationed in departure/arrival.

Checkpoints and functionality of the Artva are set up with employees of the organization.

Article 9



It is mandatory to have with him, for the duration of the competition, the material has per FIS regulation and as communicated during the briefing pre-departure technical.

Article 10

The max time to arrive at the arrival is 5 hours.

There will be an hourly gate at 11.15 at the intermediate stop at Celso Gilberti, and a time gate at 12.15 in the Sella Ursich, the competitors will be diverted to the short route.

Article 11

The immediate disqualification is foreseen, with the withdrawal of the race bib, for the following infractions:

- failure to pass from a control point;
- cutting of the race course;
- abandonment of the waste on the route;
- failure to rescue a competitor in difficulty;
- insults or threats to organizers or volunteers;
- use of means of transport during the race;

Each competitor who retires from the race out the established points, will have to Sella Nevea on his own account, communicating his withdrawal as soon as possible.

Article 12

Will be awarded the first 5 couples male and 3 female classified.

The first 5 male and 3 female absolute classifications will be awarded.

Will be awarded the first 3 man and 3 woman in the reduced course.

The athletes which awarded in the absolute classification are excluded from the prize draw.

Article 13

With the registering the competitors authorized the organization to use for free without territorial and time limits still and moving images that portray them on the occasion of participation in the event.



Article 14

The volunteering registering and subsequent participation in the race indicate the full acceptance of this regulation and any changes that are made.

With the registration, the participant exempts the organizers from any liability, both civil and criminal, for damages to persons and/or things caused by him during or after the race.
