

GREAT RACE OF LAKE LEVICO REGULATIONS Competitive race and non-competitive walk

The sports association A.S.D. Non Solo Running organises the 2nd GREAT RACE OF LAKE LEVICO, a competitive race and non-competitive walk which will take place on Friday, 20 July 2018, at 7 pm.

ROUTE

The race will take place in Levico Terme and the starting line is located in the amazing Parco Segantini.

The route is 8.8 km long (non-competitive walk) and 10.2 km long (competitive race). The route follows almost entirely a dirt road, offering magnificent views of the lake. The first part is flat, while the second part is slightly hilly.

PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS AND REGISTRATION - COMPETITVE RACE

Junior/senior categories can participate in the competitive race.

According to the rules for organising competitions set forth by FIDAL, athletes living in Italy can participate, if belonging to the following categories: Athletes who are members of clubs affiliated with FIDAL in 2018; athletes with Italian Runcard and medical certificate for competitive athletics (the card can be requested online at www.runcard.com); athletes who are members of a club affiliated to a Sports Promotion Body (in athletics), who are in possession



of a valid Italian Runcard-EPS and of a medical certificate for competitive athletics. The card can be requested online at www.runcard.com.

INFORMATION AND RESULTS

The event will take place under every weather conditions.

Results and timing service will be provided by FICR (Italian Time-Keeper Federation).

PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS AND REGISTRATION - NON-COMPETITIVE WALK

The non-competitive walk is dedicated to everyone, including those who do not have a medical certificate for competitive athletics and are not members of affiliated clubs.

However, since the walk requires some effort and technical difficulty, the participant, by signing the dedicated form, declares, under its own responsibility, to meet the physical, mental and technical requirements necessary to participate in the walk, relieving the A.S.D. Non Solo Running of any responsibility.

By registering to the event, according to Art. 3 of Decree Law No. 196/2003, each participant gives his/her consent to the processing of his/her personal data. The data will be handled for purposes of the event realisation, including but not limited to: publication of results, photos and videos taken to create a video of the event, notice boards, publication on brochures and websites. Silence is deemed to constitute assent on what is not specified above.

REGISTRATION: FEES, METHOD AND DEADLINE

Individual registration has to be made before Wednesday, 18 July 2018, by sending an e-mail to the e-mail address <u>info@latrentatrentina.com</u>, stating surname, name, birth date and contact information.

The registration fee is € 10.00 (ten/00) and include the amazing T-shirt of the event for the first 800 enrolled athletes, as well as the utilisation of 2 refreshment stations. Athletes must pay via bank transfer to the bank account hold by A.S.D. Non Solo Running, within the bank Cassa Rurale Alta Valsugana, with the following IBAN code:

Athletes may register on the day of the event, by paying a fee of \in 15.00 (fifteen/00).

By registering and paying the registration fees, each participant relieves the A.S.D. Non Solo Running of any penal or civil responsibility on what may occur to persons/objects before, during and after the event.

By registering to the event, each participant declares to have read and to fully agree on these regulations.

FIDAL AGREEMENT

Athletes who are not FIDAL members may request to become members of A.S.D. NON SOLO RUNNING, by paying a fee of € 25.00 for the membership (valid from 1 January 2018 to 31 December 2018). They must send a copy of the medical certificate for competitive ATHLETICS, valid on the day of the event, a copy of their valid ID, tax number and a photo (close-up, low resolution) the following e-mail address: to tesseramento@latrentatrentina.com. The medical certificate for competitive athletics must not be expired in order to become a member of the club. When the medical certificate for competitive athletics expires, the membership is to be considered suspended. Athletes are responsible to send to A.S.D. NON SOLO RUNNING their new valid medical certificate for competitive athletics.



UISP AGREEMENT (Promotion Body)

Athletes who wish to become members of UISP (Sports Promotion Body affiliated with FIDAL) may request to become members of A.S.D. NON SOLO RUNNING, by paying a fee of € 15.00 for the membership (valid from 1 January 2018 to 31 December 2018). They must send a copy of the medical certificate for competitive ATHLETICS, valid on the day of the event, a copy of their valid ID, tax number and a photo (close-up, low resolution) to the following e-mail address: tesseramento@latrentatrentina.com. The medical certificate for competitive athletics must not be expired in order to become a member of the club. When the medical certificate for competitive athletics expires, the membership is to be considered suspended. Athletes are responsible to send to A.S.D. NON SOLO RUNNING their new valid medical certificate for competitive athletics.

BIB AND CARD COLLECTION

BIBS (competitive race) and CARDS (non-competitive walk) must be collected at 5:30 pm at the dedicated Secretariat located in Parco Segantini, Levico Terme.

COMPETITIVE RACE VICTORY CEREMONY

The victory ceremony will take place at the end of the event. Athletes will receive prizes provided by the event organiser and the sponsors:

- o From 18 y.o to SM35 (included): first 5 athletes;
- o From 18 y.o to SF35 (included): first 5 athletes;
- o From SM40 to SM50 (included): first 5 athletes;
- o From SF40 to SF50 (included): first 5 athletes;
- o Over SM55: first 5 athletes;
- o Over SF55: first 5 athletes.



IMPORTANT: Prizes cannot be combined with other prizes. Master athletes who finish the race in the first 5 positions will be given overall prizes and not category prizes.

NON-COMPETITIVE WALK VICTORY CEREMONY

Participants in the walk of the Great Race of Lake Levico will take part in a lottery with many prizes.

PARTY

At the end of the race/walk, a great party will take place at Big Fish, located in Parco Segantini, with music, food and good beer.

IMAGE RIGHTS

By registering to the Great Race of Lake Levico, athletes expressly award the event organiser (and the legal persons with which it has professional and commercial ties for the recording of images of the event) the right to use any still or moving pictures taken during the Great Race of Lake Levico in which they may appear. The right to use the pictures is awarded free of charge and the pictures may be utilised on any visual media and in promotional and/or advertising materials that are made and broadcasted all over the world, for the maximum time permitted by the laws, regulations and agreements in force, including the possible extension that may be made to the scheduled period.

Furthermore, the event organiser may transfer to third parties, institutional and commercial partners the right to use the pictures as set forth in this agreement.

DECLARATION OF RESPONSIBILITY

By registering to the Great Race of Lake Levico, athletes accept and state that they are fully aware of these regulations, published on the official website www.latrentatrentina.com and to



at least 18 years old by 20 July 2018.

They further declare under their own responsibility to have provided only real data (Art. 2 of Law No. 15 of 04/01/1968 as modified by Art. 3, par. 10 of Law No. 127 of 15/05/1997) and to relieve the event organiser of any penal or civil responsibility for damage to persons or objects made by or derived from them.
