

Rules & Regulations Kill the Hill 2024

ARTICLE 1. PRESENTATION

Kumulus Active World 2012 S.L. is the organizer of Kill the Hill (hereinafter "the event"). All persons over the age of 18 who wish to participate can do so without distinction. The event will follow the regulations of the RFEC (Spanish Cycling Federation). This is a Cycle tourism event with the route open to traffic, it is very important that participants circulate on the right of the road and always under the safety instructions of the organization staff.

ARTICLE 2. REGISTRATION

Through the official website www.killthehill.cc., at the registration tab. There will be not entries on site.

2.1. WITHDRAW, AND ENTRIES TRANSFER

If the event is cancelled due to force majeure, (war, natural disaster, pandemic, etc.) or that must be suspended by an Administrative Order issued by the Competent Authority in the matter, the Organizer will not be obliged to reimburse the participants the amount of the registration.

Once registration has been completed, the following deadlines are being applied:

- Until 29th February (included): 100% refund*.
- Until April 14th (included): 50% refund*.

*The amount to be refunded corresponds to the registration fee. The service fees will not be refunded because this are external charges.

Until April 16th (included): transfer of the registration to the following year.

2.2. CONSIDERATIONS

The registration is personal and non-transferable and means the total acceptance of the race regulations including the waiver of civil liability.

Once the entry has been made, it cannot be transferred to any other person under any circumstances.

7:30 to 8:30 Breakfast at VIVA Blue Hotel

8:45h Briefing

9:00h Start from VIVA Blue hotel.

- 12:30h Aid station in Cúber
- 12:45h Start of the ascent to Puig Major
- 13:30h a 14:30h Special aid station at Puig Major
- 14:30h Departure of the last participant of Puig Major
- 17:00h Arrival at VIVA Blue hotel
- 17:30h Dinner at VIVA Blue hotel
- 19:00h Awards ceremony at VIVA Blue hotel

The schedule may have variations for technical and/or organizational reasons.

ARTICLE 4. RESULTS LIST

The following classifications will be made:

Overall Male and Female General Classification of the timed section 7km climb to Puig Major.

IMPORTANT: The time of each participant starts from the moment crossing the starting mat of the timed section (Puig Major access barriers).

ARTICLE 5. AWARDS

The prizes will consist in all cases of a trophy for:

- Male best climb time to Puig Major
- · Female best climb time to Puig Major
- Youngest participant
- Oldest participant
- Most numerous group/club
- Special organization award

ARTICLE 6. DISQUALIFICATIONS

Will lead to disqualification:

Provide false information on registration (age, residence, etc.)

- Not completing the full course
- Not pass through the step controls in the course
- BIB number not showed correctly or being modified
- Racing with the BIB number or/and chip from another participant
- Ignore the instructions of the organizers and/or judges during the course
- Refuse to do the doping test
- Unsporting behaviour
- Littering

ARTICLE 7. MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

All participants will be covered by accident insurance on the event day while they are in the event. The organization will have medical services to attend the participants. The organization encourages all participants to do a medical examination prior to the race. All participants accept the risks involved practicing this sport. Furthermore, the athlete declares himself in good physical condition for this race and agrees that this participation is his responsibility. Any participant with health problems is bound to previously notify this in writing to the Organization. Medical services are entitled to remove any participant from the race who appears to be in a bad physical condition.

ARTICLE 8. LIABILITY

The Organization declines any responsibility of the effects, consequences or responsibilities arising from any damage, both material and personal, caused by a participant, at the race, themselves or other people. This includes third parties cause damage to a participant, volunteer or staff of the organization.

In case a participant is ahead or behind the convoy established by the organization and/or the competent authority, they do so under their own responsibility and without the event insurance and always must respect all traffic signs.

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZED VEHICLES

Only the vehicles that are accredited by the Organization can follow the race. It is strictly forbidden to follow the runners in any type of vehicle engine or on wheels (skates, bicycles, etc...).

ARTICLE 10. ACCEPTANCE OF THE PRESENT REGULATIONS

With their registration to the race all participants accept the present rules and regulations of the race as well as the RFEC regulations. In case of doubt, the criteria of the Organization shall prevail.

ARTICLE 11. DATA PROTECTION POLICY

In compliance with the provisions of article 5 of the organic law 15/1999, of December 13th, of protection of personal character data, we inform the participants that your personal data will be treated and will be included in files of responsibility of Kumulus Active World 2012 S.L, registered at the Spanish Agency of data protection. Kumulus Active World 2012 S.L commit themselves to compliance with obligations on technical, organizational measures and safety contained in Real Decreto 1720 / 2007, of 21 December, which approves the regulations implementing the organic law 15/1999, of 13 December, of protection of personal data. That the personal data provided, as well as the images taken during the event, will be used for the purpose of the event, as well as the race final classification which will show name, category and nationality.

Image rights. The acceptance of these regulations necessarily implies that the participant authorizes the organizers of the event to record all or part of their participation therein, accepts the use of their image to promote and broadcast images of the race or any other event organized or commercialized by Kumulus Active World 2012 S.L. or any other all formats (radio, print, video, photos, internet, posters, media, etc.) and transfers all rights



to commercial and advertising deemed appropriate, without any entitlement to receive financial compensation.
