



# **GALICAN** **AGILITY CUP** **RULES &** **REGULATIONS**



## **CASTEJON DE SOS 24-25-26 June 2017**

Galican Agility Cup is an agility competition open to all dogs, crossbreed or purebred dogs, pedigreed or not. All dog associations are kindly invited to attend and participate in this great event. For practical and organizational reasons, up to **750 dogs** will be allowed to participate in the competition and, of these, Large category will account for no more than 50%. All participants will enter in our GALICAN prize drawing.

### **GALICAN AGILITY CUP - Qualifying rounds**

#### **Individual Competition - Qualifying round: 24 June**

The qualifying rounds for the individual finals will be held on **24 June 2017**, separately for each category **Large, Medium, Small**.

A qualifying round will consist of one **Agility** run and one **Jumping** run (for each category). Each course will be scored separately, having its own ranking depending on the respective faults and total time.

As to the **Large** category, the **top 25 dogs** in the Agility run and the top 25 in the Jumping run will qualify for the final. For **Medium** and **Small** same will apply for the **top 15**, respectively. In case of a dog qualifying in both runs, its place in that ranking in which it holds a worse position will be freed for the next dog in line. And so on, until 50 dogs in the Large category, 30 in Medium and 30 in Small fill out the

list for the finals. Where a dog holds the same position in both runs, the place freed will be that in the jumping ranking.

The 2016 GALICAN AGILITY CUP winners 2016 go straight to the final.

## **Team Competition - Qualifying rounds: 25 June**

The qualifying rounds for the Team finals will be held on **25 June 2017**, under two different classes, **Team Large** and mixed **Team Medium-Small**.

Both Large teams and Small-Medium teams may have 3 or 4 handler/dog members. For the mixed teams, there is no requirement in relation to the share of Medium or Small members

To qualify for the Team final, participants shall run both an **Agility** course and a **Jumping** course.

After a run, participants will be ranked according to the number of faults and the total time. The score points for the top position will be equal to the number of participants ( $\leq$  number of teams  $\times$  4); second, same score but 1 point less; third position, the score of the winner less 2 points; and so on. Those eliminated score 0 points.

The Team score is the result of adding the scores of the 3 top members of the team. The top 10 Teams will qualify for the Large final and the respective top 10 to the Small-Medium final, taking the top positions from the ranking of the total score in both runs. In case of a tie, the score of the 4th member of the team will be taken into account. If there is still a tie, the score of the best member will decide.

# **GALICAN AGILITY CUP - Finals**

## **INDIVIDUAL FINAL**

The **GALICAN AGILITY CUP Individual Final** will be a 1 run-competition -a Grade III Agility course- that will take place after concluding the qualifying rounds on June 24th. Just before, we'll have an opening ceremony with a big parade of all participating clubs and countries.

The starting list for the individual Final is set as follows:

- The top 50 Large/ 30 Medium / 30 Small in the Jumping and Agility qualifiers will jump in the reverse order of qualification results alternating between both lists (i.e., the last one will be the Agility winner, the second-to-last one will be the Jumping winner and so on).
- Last year winners will be at the bottom of the list: the last ones jumping in the Final.

The fastest dog (from any size category) running the dog-walk at the Final will win **THE DOG-WALK!!!**

The winners at the Final will win the title of

**“Campeón Individual Large/ Medium/Small 2017 - GALICAN AGILITY CUP”**  
**(Individual Champion 2017 GALICAN AGILITY CUP Large/ Medium/Small)**

and they will be awarded with a diploma, a rosette, a special GALICAN prize and more and more surprise gifts.

Large Medium and Small Individual Champions will compete in a further round (same course for they all) and the best one will win the title of

**“CAMPEÓN ABSOLUTO GALICAN AGILITY CUP 2017”**  
**(ABSOLUTE CHAMPION 2017 GALICAN AGILITY CUP)**



# TEAM FINAL

The **GALICAN AGILITY CUP Team Final** is a team relay competition over four independent courses but fitted in an extended huge Agility ring where some obstacles are shared. Time will be started when the first dog crosses the starting line and time will be stopped when the 4<sup>th</sup> and last dog crosses the finishing line. If a team member is eliminated he will be scored a 100 points penalty and team total time will automatically rise to the “maximum time” (as agreed and set). The 15 teams will jump in the reverse order of qualification results so that the best team will jump the last at the Final.

Team members at the Final shall be the same as in the qualifying rounds. If a team with only 3 members in the Qualifiers reach the final, there one team member will have to run 2 courses.

Team Final winners will win the title of

**“Campeón por Equipos GALICAN AGILITY CUP 2017”**  
**(Team Champion 2017 GALICAN AGILITY CUP)**

and they will be awarded with a diploma, a rosette, a special GALICAN prize and more and more surprise gifts.





## **SPECIAL JUMPING with K.O. FINALS - 26 June**

Competition will take place on Monday, June 26<sup>th</sup>, starting at 9 am.

FCI Regulations for Jumping class, i.e. without contact obstacles will apply

The competition will consist in one Jumping run, qualifying for a K.O. final (knockout tournament).

The 31 top positions in category Large and the top 15 in each category, Medium and Small, in the corresponding Jumping runs will be short-listed for their respective finals.

In addition, the fastest dog of the run (by categories) will be enabled to participate in the final, no matter penalties (though not higher than 10 points); that is to say that the fastest dog of the jumping run in each category will qualify directly to its respective final.

The last elimination K.O. round in each category (when only 2 dogs remain competing) will consist in a triple K.O. duel (best 2-of-3).

There will be also a 3-dog K.O. final among the best one from each category –Large, Medium and Small.

Trophies and rosettes will be awarded to finalists together with surprise gifts for the champions, highly special for the Absolute Champion.

## **TUNEL CUP - 26 June**

Tunnel Cup will take place just after the Special Jumping

Any dog, any age will be allowed to participate. There will be only 2 jumps, without the bar, respectively opening and closing the course. Everything else will be tunnels

Winners at each category will receive a GALICAN tunnel.
